“Be on your guard and avoid every kind of greed...LK 12:15 (CCB)

You may have heard of the old American Indian saying which says “There are two wolves within us, one good and one bad” and the one that wins is the one we feed.

There are two wolves within us one is called “need” and the other “greed”. The one we feed will win. Greed is a manifestation of insecurity. If we are insecure the evil one will tempt us and if we feed this wolf we will trip and fall. Because we are insecure we want what God has in store for us tomorrow today. Hence we acquire more possessions like property, clothes, cars and many other things which feed this insecurity we have.

Our faith also feeds into this insecurity with various religious activities like novenas, and devotions and other activities. Although these activities are good for those of us who are insecure it gives us a place to hide. /we can be busy but going nowhere.

B.U.S.Y. stands for Being Under Satan's Yoke.

The world feeds this with need for buying stuff or taking vacations. So even though we cannot afford it we borrow and get into debt, and then become slaves to the evil one and come under his yoke by being “BUSY.”

God gives us what we need. True faith is doing things daily. Jesus told his disciples of that time, to take up their crosses daily and follow him. The prayer that he taught was “...give us this day our daily bread.”

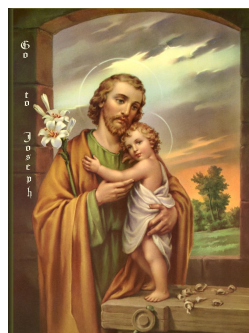
