What a wonderful retreat time we had with Fr.Maria Selvan. When I asked him to pray over the theme he told me he was getting "Come to the top of the mountain". I wondered how this might fit the Lenten theme. But his three talks were so prayerfully constructed that I truly felt the Lord speaking to me.


